## Pinot Noir

- ‡ **Domaine Serene Evanstad Reserve, Willamette Valley** \$120  
Harmonious balance of structure, richness and acidity with soft tannins and a clean, lingering finish
- ‡ **Archery Summit Premier Cuvee, Willamette Valley, Oregon** \$75  
Dark chocolate, blackberry, plum and earth aromas
- ‡ **Erath Estate, Willamette Valley, Oregon** \$69  
A bright palate of red plums and currants affords a sweet, juicy entry that builds and flows with a subtle smokiness.
- ‡ **Etude, Carneros, California** \$60  
Beautifully structured and lush, loaded with complex layers of cherries, spice, and hints of earth, with a silky finish
- ‡ **Four Graces, Willamette Valley, Oregon** \$56  
Earthy and elegant with expressive tannins and dark red fruit
- ‡ **Lincourt "Lindsay's", Santa Rita Hills, California** \$50  
Notes of dark plum, black cherry and hints of cedar and vanilla, round, soft and elegant
- ‡ **Irony, Monterey, California** \$40  
Aromas of black cherry, sweet plum, cocoa, and violet. Supple tannins and balanced acidity are complimented on the palate with sweet, lush fruit flavors
- ‡ **Angeline, California** \$36  
Round and juicy with lively acidity, and a touch of sweet, toasty oak on the finish

## Merlot

- ‡ **Emmolo, Napa Valley, California** \$70  
Superbly rich fruit, soft tannins, smoke and spice
- ‡ **Rombauer, Napa Valley** \$60  
This medium-bodied wine is soft and subtle with flavors of plums and cherries, leading to an aromatic finish that displays a distinct freshness
- ‡ **Stags Leap, Napa Valley, California** \$55  
Aromatics of ripe red cherry and sweet strawberry jam lead to flavors of rich red fruit, toasted almonds, and a hint of black truffles
- ‡ **Greystone Cellars, California** \$36  
Lush flavors of ripe plums and black cherry with a tannin structure from beginning to end.

## Cabernet Sauvignon

- ‡ **Caymus, Napa Valley, California** \$125  
Balanced, rich, expressive and impressively complex. The backbone of fine tannin and sweet ripeness is a carry over from perfectly mature fruit
- ‡ **Brandlin Estate, Mount Veeder, California** \$95  
Overflowing with boysenberry, black cherry and notes of olive and sage, long, silky tannins on the finish.
- ‡ **Faust, Napa Valley, California** \$79  
A lush, full entry on the palate with blackberry, cassis, nutmeg and dark chocolate flavors leads to a plush, supple mouthfeel
- ‡ **Kenwood "Jack London", Sonoma Mountain, California** \$66  
Fruity aromas of dried cherries and black raspberries combine with aromatic notes of thyme, sage and a touch of vanilla. The wine has a rich, full bodied mouthfeel with an excellent finish
- ‡ **Charles Krug, Yountville, Napa Valley, California** \$55  
This polished wine opens with aromas of black cherry, currant and a hint of tobacco. On the palate, cocoa and cassis blend with supple tannins that lead to a graceful, elegant finish
- ‡ **Avalon, Napa Valley, California** \$52  
Layers of red cherries and blackberries, backed by vanilla and toasted oak
- ‡ **Divining Rod, Alexander Valley, California** \$48  
Lively aromatics of direct herbs, tea and vanilla flavors include black currants, red licorice, earl gray tea and toasted oak
- ‡ **Double Canyon, Horse Heaven Hills, Washington** \$44  
An array of ripe red and black plum, intermixed with notes of fresh red cherry

## Shiraz, Syrah & Petite Sirah

- ‡ **Marietta "Christo," North Coast, California** \$48  
Blend of Syrah, Grenache, Petite Sirah and Viognier. Complex layers of stone, lavender and dark juicy fruit
- ‡ **Boom Boom Syrah, Columbia Valley, Washington** \$44  
Aromas of fresh picked herbs and earth. rich black cherry and tobacco are followed by hints of lavender on the finish. An explosive dark cherry bomb!
- ‡ **Guenoc Petite Sirah, Lake County, California** \$40  
Full and soft mouthfeel intense with blueberry and vanilla make this a powerful yet elegant wine
- ‡ **M. Chapoutier "Belleruche" Cotes-du-Rhone, France** \$38  
A blend of 50% Syrah and 50% Grenache this is a mouthful of bright lively fruit with a great backbone

## Zinfandel

- ‡ **Seghesio, Sonoma, California** \$48  
Tantalizing raspberry, blueberry, classic briary and spicy flavors with a balance of components
- ‡ **Brady, Paso Robles, California** \$39  
Aromas of raspberry and black pepper, with subtle notes of vanilla and spice. Savory berry and bramble flavors echo the aromas
- ‡ **Cartlidge & Brown, North Coast, California** \$36  
Bursting with aromas of ripe black cherry, a little blueberry and brown sugar. Rich berry and soft chocolate linger long on the palate, mingling with soft tannins and spice

## Reds That Rock

- ‡ **Barbera, Marchesi di Barolo, Piedmont, Italy** \$32  
Wild berries, currants, and black cherry are accompanied by a hint of vanilla and toasted oak. The flavor is warm and robust, full-bodied, pleasant and balanced
- ‡ **Tempranillo, Campo Viejo Reserva, Rioja, Spain** \$40  
This rustic wine exhibits great balance between fruit flavors of cherries, black plums, and ripe blackberries with the nuances of clove, pepper, and vanilla coming from the oak aging
- ‡ **Malbec, Trapiche Broquel, Mendoza, Argentina** \$36  
Red and black fruits, floral notes, and earthy minerals, with an elegant touch of smoke. Rich and spicy with a long and pleasant finish
- ‡ **Malbec, Luigi Bosca, Mendoza Argentina** \$45  
Deep ruby red color, with aromas of ripe red fruit, spices and black pepper. The palate intensity is complimented by the soft, sweet tannins, and a well structured full body
- ‡ **Carmenere, Haras de Pirque, Maipo Valley, Chile** \$32  
Rich in the nose with red fruits, spices, and fresh tobacco notes. In the mouth it is soft and juicy with a pleasant balance
- ‡ **Bordeaux Blend, Chappellet Mountain Cuvee, Napa Valley, California** \$52  
Plum and cherry flavors mingle with sweet oak, cocoa and baking spices. While supple tannins and a smooth, lingering texture make this wine immediately pleasurable
- ‡ **Red Blend, Kumbaya, California** \$32  
Ripe blackberry and current with spicy accents, smooth and velvety on the finish
- ‡ **Red Blend, Noble Vines 1, California** \$36  
This blend of Merlot, Cabernet, and Zinfandel offers rich flavors of blackberry and black cherry mingled with hints of spice
- ‡ **Red Blend, Cline Cashmere, California** \$44  
Delicious blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre with a silky texture. A wait staff favorite!

## Bubbles

- Astoria Prosecco, Veneto, Italy (375ml)** \$18
- ‡ **Astoria Prosecco, Veneto, Italy (750ml)** \$38  
An intense fruity bouquet with a hint of golden apples. It is dry, fresh, light in body and well-balanced
- ‡ **Mumm Napa Brut Prestige, Napa Valley, California** \$44  
This sparkling wine features fine bright citrus, red apples, stone fruit, and creamy vanilla aromas with hints of toast, honey, and gingerbread spice
- ‡ **Mumm Napa Sparkling Rose, Napa Valley, California** \$48  
Versatile and food friendly, this wine is direct with soft fruity flavor, and the right fit for date night, or girls night out
- Perrier Jouet Grand Brut, Champagne, France** \$80  
This light, delicate Brut offers a wide array of flavors including white flowers, white fruit, pineapple and grapefruit

## Sauvignon Blanc

- ‡ **Emmolo, Napa Valley, California** \$48  
Crisp and soft with a hint of honeysuckle and underlying notes of tangerine
- ‡ **Ferrari Carano Fume Blanc, Sonoma, California** \$40  
Delicious aromas of white peach, orange blossom, quince, and mango are complemented by flavors of grapefruit, pear and Meyer lemon
- ‡ **Matua, Marlborough, New Zealand** \$36  
Tropical and citrus fruits along with herbaceous varietal characters. Generous and fruit-driven palate with classical acidity, giving structure and length

## Chardonnay

- Domaine Serene Evanstad Reserve, Willamette Valley** \$80  
Balanced and elegant this wine delivers firm acidity, richness and persistence
- ‡ **Rombauer, Carneros, California** \$60  
Rich with layers of peaches, pears, and tropical fruit. Creamy textures glide across the palate. Buttery!
- ‡ **Chalk Hill, Sonoma Coast, California** \$59  
Rich, full and citrusy with traces of butterscotch and vanilla in the finish. The fruit is reigned in by great acidity and has a persistent flavor
- ‡ **Raeburn, Russian River, California** \$48  
Elegant layering of toasty, vanilla overtones on top of bright fruit flavors leading into a graceful finish
- ‡ **Sonoma-Cutrer, Sonoma Coast, California** \$45  
The wine is elegant and balanced with a nice, bright acidity. Zesty flavor of lime, lemon drop and grapefruit are accented with peach notes and a nice barrel spice
- ‡ **Chateau St Jean "Bijou" Chardonnay, California** \$40  
Vibrant and crisp fruit forward flavors of peach, pineapple, and passion fruit with just a kiss of French oak
- ‡ **La Merika, Central Coast, California** \$36  
This wine has aromas of tropical fruit, lemon, spice, and vanilla that pair nicely with its flavors of pineapple, melon, and toasted oak

## Pinot Grigio & Pinot Gris

- ‡ **Campanile, Friuli, Italy** \$40  
Fresh acidity, light and pleasant nutty flavors with a long finish
- ‡ **Erath Pinot Gris, Oregon** \$36  
Crisp, clean and refreshing; tangy flavors leave you a juicy mouthfeel of peaches and pears

## Extraordinary Whites & Rosés

- ‡ **Vinho Verde, Lola, Portugal** \$36  
Fruity, fresh, harmonious and slightly spritzy
- ‡ **Gruener Veltliner, Biokult, Austria** \$40  
Fresh crisp citrus, lively acidity, finished by a creamy, ripe texture
- ‡ **Blanc, M. Chapoutier "Belleruche," Cotes-du-Rhone, France** \$36  
Fresh and well balanced, with citrus and green apple
- ‡ **Viognier, Cline, California** \$36  
This aromatic grape varietal presents with a full-bodied peach flavor
- ‡ **Chenin Blanc, Protea, South Africa** \$40  
Fresh, crisp fruit with hints of pear, citrus and honeysuckle. The wine is created in a lighter style for early enjoyment
- ‡ **Chenin Blanc, Monmousseau Vouvray, Loire Valley, France** \$36  
Ripe with all of the floral, honey and white peach notes, characteristics of Chenin. This off-dry wine is balanced by citrus acidity and a delicious minerality
- ‡ **Riesling, Saint M, Pfalz, Germany** \$32  
Highly aromatic with traces of ripe apricots, peaches, honey, and tangerine zest, providing a subtle sweetness well matched by crisp acidity
- ‡ **Rosé, Domaine Serene "R", Oregon** \$48  
Notes of citrus blossom, fresh strawberries and passion fruit, with fresh acidity and a creamy mid palate
- ‡ **Rosé, Sokol Blosser, Dundee Hills, Oregon** \$40  
Touch of apple, watermelon and bright acidity
- ‡ **Rosé, La Petite Cassagne, Nimes, France** \$32  
This dry rose is comprised of Cinsault, Syrah and Grenache. Intensely fragrant up front, moving to flavors of framboise, earth, spice and a crisp acidity on the finish
